'OLD VINE' MALBEC, BONARDA

Boutique winery Algodon Wine Estates boast some very fine old Bonarda and Malbec vines, dating from 1946.

Winemaking is led by Mauro Nonsenzo and aided by Mendoza and Bordeaux oenologist Marcelo Pelleriti and British Master of Wine Anthony Foster.

Blend: 70% Malbec & 30% Bonarda

Location: San Rafael, Mendoza

Country: Argentina

Vintage: 2015

Alcohol: 14.5% ABV

Viticulture: Vines planted in 1946 low trained bilateral cordon and Guyot.

Vinification: The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barriques.

Tasting Note: Smoke, blueberries and dark berried fruits fill the nose. The palate is full bodied with crunchy black cherry, currants and toasty oak flavours.

Food Match: This is perfect to serve with herb crusted rack of lamb with a Port jus.
