Boutique winery Algodon Wine Estates boast some very fine old Bonarda and Malbec vines, dating from 1946.

Winemaking is led by Mauro Nonsenzo and aided by Mendoza and Bordeaux oenologist Marcelo Pelleriti and British Master of Wine Anthony Foster.

Blend: 70% Malbec, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Syrah & 5% Merlot

Location: San Rafael, Mendoza

Alcohol: 14.5% ABV

Viticulture: High and low trained vines, Bilateral cordon and Guyot

Vinification: The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barriques.

Tasting Note: A forward & plush nose of brambles, liquorice and cigar leads to a firm and full bodied palate. Spices, dark fruits and bitter chocolate fill the mouth ahead of a refreshing and long finish.

Food Match: Pair with venison in a blackberry sauce.
