Boutique winery Algodon Wine Estates boast some very fine old Bonarda and Malbec vines, dating from 1946.

Winemaking is led by Mauro Nonsenzo and aided by Mendoza and Bordeaux oenologist Marcelo Pelleriti and British Master of Wine Anthony Foster.

Blend: 100% Malbec

Location: San Rafael, Mendoza

Country: Argentina

Vintage: 2015

Alcohol: 14.5% ABV

Viticulture: High trained bilateral cordon.

Vinification: The wine is aged for 14 months in French oak barriques.

Tasting Note: This is a full and intense expression of Malbec. Ripe black fruits, autumnal notes and vanilla all show on the nose. The palate is full bodied, unctuous and rich with flavours of cherry liqueur, damson and raisins. Soft smoky tannins provide a lovely mouthfeel.

Food Match: Pair with roast beef with a thyme and fennel crust.
