Boutique winery Algodon Wine Estates boast some very fine old Bonarda and Malbec vines, dating from 1946.

Winemaking is led by Mauro Nonsenzo and aided by Mendoza and Bordeaux oenologist Marcelo Pelleriti and British Master of Wine Anthony Foster.

Blend: 100% Pinot Noir

Location: San Rafael, Mendoza

Country: Argentina

Viticulture: High trained bilateral cordon.

Vinification: The wine is aged for 14 months in French oak barriques.

Tasting Note: Vanilla, mocha and dark fruits fill the enticing nose. The palate is rich and offers a fuller style of Pinot but retains elegance. The palate is smooth with dark cherries, sandalwood and creamy vanilla flavours. This is superbly textured Pinot Noir.

Food Match: Serve with rich gamey meats like duck, pheasant or pigeon.
