The property has been in the Fallabrino family since 1947; winemaker Pablo Fallabrino produces quality-driven wines in small quantities utilising a modern winery but at the same time continues to explore forgotten, old or less-known wine-making techniques.

'Viñedo de los Vientos' translates into "Vineyard of the Winds" and is located where the river Plate estuary and the Atlantic Ocean meet, providing clean cool ocean breezes and an ideal climate for the maturation of fine wine grapes.

Blend: 100% Tannst

Location: Atlántida

Country: Uruguay

Vintage: 2017

Alcohol: 14% ABV

Viticulture: Low yields and hand harvesting is employed to ensure only the best fruit is used.

Vinification: Grapes are handpicked from sustainably farmed (soon to be certified organic) vineyards. Fermentation using indigenous yeasts over 7 days at 30-35 °C with several pump-overs. The wine is then aged for 9 months below 0°C to ensure stabilisation and some racking is done during this period. This is followed by a light filtration before bottling in the summer.

Tasting Note: Deep purple colour, black olive and dark berry fruits to the fore on the nose and palate with a firm yet supple tannic structure and fresh acidity.
