CATARSIS

The property has been in the Fallabrino family since 1947; winemaker Pablo Fallabrino produces quality-driven wines in small quantities utilising a modern winery but at the same time continues to explore forgotten, old or less-known wine-making techniques.

'Viñedo de los Vientos' translates into "Vineyard of the Winds" and is located where the river Plate estuary and the Atlantic Ocean meet, providing clean cool ocean breezes and an ideal climate for the maturation of fine wine grapes.

Blend: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Tannat & 30% Barbera

Location: Atlántida

Country: Uruguay

Vintage: 2017

Alcohol: 13.5% ABV

Viticulture: Low yields and hand harvesting is employed to ensure only the best fruit is used.

Vinification: Cold macerated for 5 days at 6° C for extract the fruity flavours with a daily pump over. Fermentation is at 25 °C for 7 days with daily "delestage". The wine is left in French oak barrels for 18 months.

Tasting Note: Delicate aromas of vanilla and toast with cherry and eucalyptus. The palate exhibits medium to full body, soft tannins, fresh acidity and a long finish.

Food Match: Red meats, beef and lamb stews, strong cheese and mushroom dishes.
