Blend: 100% Malbec

Location: San Carlos, La Consulta, Uco Valley, Mendoza

Country: Argentina

Vintage: 2016

Alcohol: 14% ABV

Viticulture: VPS, Drip Irrigation

Vinification: Cold maceration for 5 days, followed by fermentation for 28 days at a maximum temperature of 30°C and 100% Malolactic. 15 months ageing in first fill French oak barriques.

Tasting Note: A full bodied, rich wine revealing deliciously ripe black fruit flavours supported by black cherries and juicy plums, there are also hints of violets and vanilla spice from the time spent in oak; full-bodied and seductive with great texture and a long finish.
