An increasingly fine portfolio of wines is produced from premium vineyard sites in Mendoza, where they utilise high altitude to impart character and freshness in their wines.

**Blend:** 100% Malbec

**Location:** East Mendoza & Uco Valley

**Country:** Argentina

**Vintage:** 2019

**Alcohol:** 12.5% ABV

**Viticulture:** VPS Drip Irrigation.

**Vinification:** Stainless steel fermentation, no oak.

**Tasting Note:** A brambly nose leads to a soft, juicy and round palate with redcurrants, blackcurrants and plums. Soft tannins and a nice thread of acidity make this a lovely everyday Malbec.

**Food Match:** This wine will work perfectly with steak, sausage & mash or pasta with a meat or tomato sauce.
