For many years, the isolated mountain valleys of northern Argentina were home to the Incas. Today the valleys are home to the highest vineyards in the world, lying at an altitude of nearly 2,000 metres above sea level. Here the crystal clear skies, pure mountain air, and a long cool growing season provide perfect conditions for the fifth-generation of the Lavaque winemaking family to produce the highest quality grapes, using sustainable biodynamic farming methods.

Winemaker

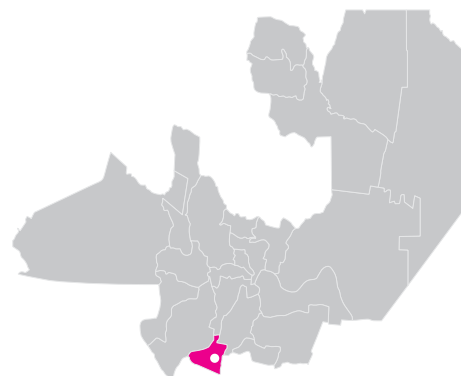
Pancho Lavaque, winemaker, is the fifth generation of the family of winemakers, in Cafayate Valley since 1889. He studied at UC Davis School in the United States, which has one of the world's most renowned viticulture and winemaking programs. After graduating in Viticulture and Oenology in 2003, Pancho returned to Argentina to start working with his father at the family cellars of Mendoza and Cafayate, beginning to develop the foreign trade sector with the goal of spreading Argentine wine around the world.
