Winemaker

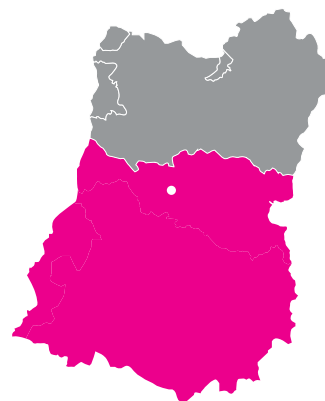
